Code of Conduct

This code of conduct pertains to all players, parents, coaches, Director/Technical Trainer, trainers, board members and any other person associated in any manner, whether a guest or a supporter of a GYSC member or in any way represents GYSC. The purpose of this code is to promote a safe enjoyable environment for everyone involved with the sport of soccer under GYSC.

Any action determined by the GYSC board to be in violation of the code may result in suspension or removal of said violator from GYSC. It is also noted that, in addition to rules and regulations set forth by GYSC, GYSC also operates under the guidelines of rules and regulations of the Central Pennsylvania Youth Soccer League (CPYSL) and the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association (EPYSA).

Depending on the severity of the offense as noted below, the infraction of the code could result in any, or all, of the following; a written warning from the GYSC board, a one game suspension, or disqualification of the violator for the remainder of the season from GYSC involved events.

Conduct that would be considered in violation of the code would include, but not limited to:

- 1. Verbal abuse of any Referee.
- 2. Verbal abuse of any player, coach, parent, or spectator of GYSC or any other club.
- 3. Use of profanity, or inappropriate gestures, at any time, directed at anyone.
- 4. Any act, that in opinion of the GYSC board, that does not promote good sportsmanship or is deemed detrimental to the club or any person involved with the club or any other club.

Conduct resulting in the immediate disqualification and removal from the club without any type of refund, would include but not limited to:

- 1. Physical abuse of any Referee.
- 2. Physical abuse of any player, coach, parent or spectator of GYSC or any other club.
- 3. Any act, in the opinion of the GYSC board, that affects, or could affect, the safety of any individual involved with any GYSC involved event.

It is noted that coaches will be responsible for the conduct of the team and fans associated with the team. Thus, coaches may act as agents of the board and make decisions that they feel need immediate attention, until the time that the GYSC board has an opportunity to review the circumstances. An example may be to control a player, or person, while attending a tournament or match.
